In his second solo album, Søren Jordan shows a very broad variety of bluesy instrumental tunes. The opener of the CD „1968“ starts out like an intro to a Pink Floyd song, then turns into a wild 6/8 beat with sounds that bring back the vibes of the late 60s, the years of the young Hendrix and Clapton. the rest of the album includes funky tracks, latin grooves, fat shuffle rhythms, jazzy minor blues tunes, a dreamy ballad and even a short raw Delta Blues played with a slide on steelstring accoustic guitar. All basic tracks were recorded live, by a real tight band, like in the old days, with creative players on all positions, that`s why the CD sounds so vivid and interactive. The album has an exiting mixture of styles and sounds. All this is held together by the guitar of S.Jordan, always bluesy, always serving the song, with a beautiful tone and a broad variety of retro sounds. A CD, not just for guitarplayers.
